

## **Position Description**

### **AG 1011 SAM**

**Statement of Purpose** - AG 1011 SAMs assist with the AG 1011 freshmen orientation course by serving as mentors and group discussion facilitators to small groups of students. Through this leadership role, returning students have the opportunity to assist new freshmen students with their transition into OSU and CASNR by answering questions and providing guidance from a student's perspective. AG 1011 SAMs also assist the course professor and teaching assistants with class activities, announcements, group activities, and other class functions.

#### **1) Student Success Leader Qualifications**

- Currently pursuing an academic major within CASNR, and continued work towards a CASNR major throughout 2018-2019 academic year
- 3.0 cumulative GPA at the time of application and maintained through the semester of service
- At least 12 hours of earned college credit by beginning of 2018-2019 academic year (Ambassador candidates must have at least 12 hours earned at OSU-Stillwater)

#### **2) AG 1011 Responsibilities**

- Attend and participate in one section of the AG 1011, Freshmen Orientation course the first 8 weeks of class during the fall semester (Fall 2018)
- Reach out weekly, at a minimum, to assigned small group during the 8 weeks of class
- Review weekly emails regarding the upcoming week's schedule and respond in a timely manner
  - Emails are to inform AG 1011 SAMs of the weekly course material, provide training and to ensure the AG 1011 SAMs have the resources and knowledge to assist students
