Fall 2017 MATH Pilot Corequisite Sections

The Department of Mathematics will offer several corequisite sections of MATH courses in the Fall 2017 semester. We will offer the same corequisite sections of MATH 1483 and 1513 that we did in Fall 2016 and potentially some additional sections if demand warrants and if we have sufficient personnel. For the first time, we will offer corequisite sections of MATH 2144 as well.

Enrollment procedure

Because of limitations in Banner for testing for a placement score in a certain range, the sections are set up to require departmental permission. Advisors who have a student who meets the prerequisites and would like to enroll should send an e-mail **to all of the following people**:

MATH 1483

<u>Prerequisites</u>: A score of 25-34 on the Math Placement Test. The student should be in a degree plan that does not require MATH 1513.

<u>Course schedule and CRNs</u>: The course meets every day for 50 minutes. Attendance at all five class periods each week is required. The schedule is:

• MWF 10:30-11:20 in CLB 303 and TR 1030-11:20 in HSCI 004. **CRN: 67703.**

MATH 1513

<u>Prerequisites</u>: A score of 30-44 on the Math Placement Test. The student should be in a degree (or career) plan that requires MATH 1513 or higher and does not allow 1483 or 1493.

<u>Course schedule and CRNs</u>: The course meets every day for 50 minutes. Attendance at all five class periods each week is required. There are three options:

- MWF 9:30-10:20 in CLB 219 and TR 9:30-10:20 in Edmon Low Library 517B (MLSC).
 CRN: 67451.
- MWF 10:30-11:20 in CLB 201 and TR 11:30-12:20 in Edmon Low Library 517B (MLSC).

• MWF 12:30-1:20 in CLB 307 and TR 12:30-1:20 in STOUT 044.

CRN: 62434.

MATH 2144

The following two sections are for students with placement scores below the cut-off of 75.

<u>Prerequisites</u>: A score of 70-74 on the Math Placement Test. The student should be in a degree (or career) plan that requires MATH 2144.

<u>Course schedule and CRNs</u>: The course meets MWF for 75 minutes and TR for 50 minutes. Attendance at all five class periods each week is required. There are two options, both with the same schedule:

- MWF 8:00-9:15 and TR 8:00-8:50, all days in MSCS 514. Instructor: Dr. Mills.
 CRN: 62910.
- MWF 8:00-9:15 and TR 8:00-8:50, all days in MSCS 422. Instructor: Dr. Tallman. CRN: 62921.

Other ways to qualify: Each of the two sections above will have roughly 15 seats for students with Math Placement Test scores in the 70-74 range. Another 15 seats in each classroom will be saved for students who are transferring the prerequisite and want extra help and for those who do not do well on the first-week diagnostic test and wish to parachute to the five-day-per-week sections. The CRNs for those seats will be announced later. The times and locations will be as above. The students will be in the same classroom as the students with scores of 70-74, just identified differently in Banner to enable us to get a balance of each type of student and to track student progress.

<u>Note for all courses</u>: Many students would benefit from working through the ALEKS learning modules and attempting to improve their placement score to move to a regular section of 1483, 1513, or 2144. The Department will prioritize finding a seat in a regular section for any student who is able to move out of the corequisite sections after earning a higher placement score.
